## **Becoming a GP Clinical Supervisor (CS)**

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#### Step 1- Am I eligible?

You must be a GP working a minimum of four clinical sessions,
Been a qualified GP for 12 months at time of CS accreditation,
A salaried Doctor or partner in the practice for at least 6 months (not a Locum or Retainer Doctor).





#### Step 2 - Will my practice support me?

Discuss your CS aspirations with your current GP Practice.

Red CQC ratings should be resolved first.





#### Step 3 - How do I apply?

This <u>online survey</u> is where you should submit your 'Expression of Interest'.





#### **Step 4 - When is the training offered?**

Your eligibility will be checked and then you will be invited to the next CS one-day course. Future course dates are included on the **HEE KSS webpage**. These are held virtually.





#### **Step 5 - How do I prepare?**

You will need to complete these short <u>e-Learning</u> <u>modules</u> prior to the training course.

They are free of charge and will take around an hour and a half to complete.
